


## WESTECK 425 & GrandView Patio Openings


Field Installation - Fixed Panels












- Check frame that proper installation of weather-stripping has been applied. Weather-strips should be continuous with no breaks or tears. Note, welded corners may have some burn off removed.
- Remove all threshold cover and jamb track covers, noting what tracks they are from.


  Set glazed fixed panel onto the setting block track and slide into jamb pocket, tight to the jamb spacer blocks, with glazing stops and drainage holes to the exterior and interlock facing interior.
- Once the fixed panels are set into the frame, anchor the head of the main frame to structure, ensure to keep level.
- Check panel is square to frame, and weather-stripping is compressing against the frame towers.







Install one #8 x 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " screw into the jamb tower 3" up from sill, through the weather-strip slot.













Install two #8 x 2 ½" screws through the frame tower through weather-strip slot at the sill at interlock end of the panel. See image for correct angle. Use caution to not over tighten which may strip screws.



- (12) Install threshold and jamb/head track covers.
- Install operating panel, check for interlocks meeting between fixed and operator. There should be no binding or excessive play once the door is closed and locked.

## Quality checks after Install

There should be minimal play at the interlock, < .25" (6mm). If excessive, check fixed panels are seated completely into the jambs snug to the spacer blocks. Tower to panel daylight should be no more than 2.625" (66.7MM) at jamb, and 3" (76MM) at sill.

Check frame and panels for square. No more than 1/8" (2MM) on panels and 3/16" (3MM) on frames diagonally should be found.
